# REDEVELOPMENT NEWS

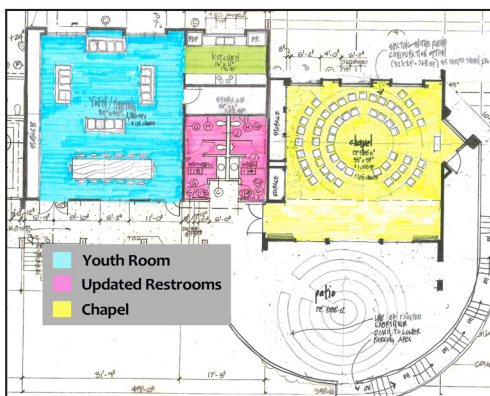
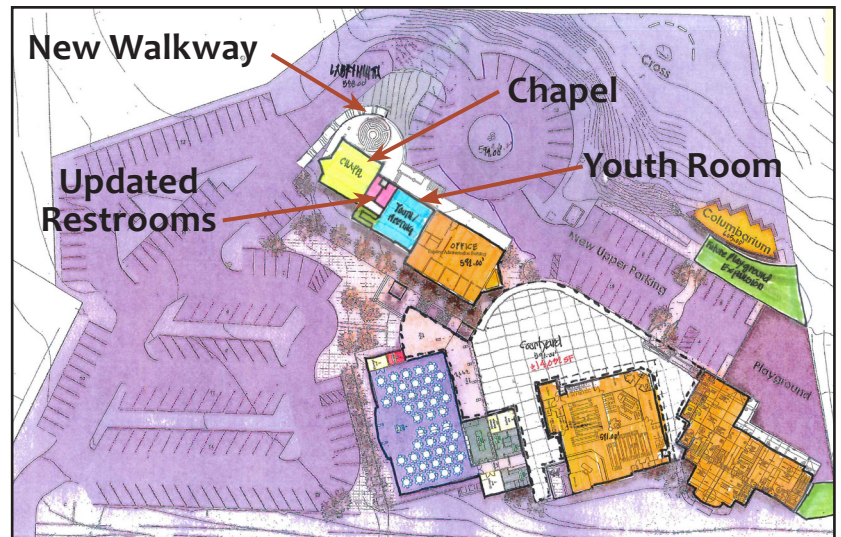

**St. Bart's redevelopment is underway!** Our campus redevelopment plan honors the legacy of those before us and prayerful recommendations of today's Parishioners. We are transforming our campus to serve the Episcopal Church of the 21st century. The design provides improved campus accessibility with more handicapped parking spaces and ground level access with a large elevator, covered stairs and multiple ramps. The new two-story Parish Community Center features multi-purpose rooms for small and large gatherings, commercial kitchen and ADA (access and disability) compliant restrooms.

## New Chapel Location

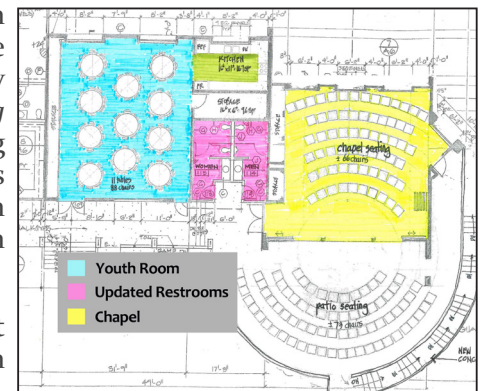
With feedback from our parishioners, the Architectural (ARCH) Committee revised the campus design plans to create a Chapel. We'll create a Chapel in the current Youth Room. A redesigned space adjacent to the church office will provide a larger Youth/Multi-Purpose Room with kitchenette. The existing restrooms, located between the new Chapel and Youth Room, will be updated to meet ADA codes. A new sidewalk from the lower parking lot will provide an additional walkway to this redesigned area.

**Plan Detail Views** The updated plan provides flexible use of existing space. The *left rendering* illustrates 115 seating capacity in the indoor Chapel. The *right rendering* shows expanded indoor-outdoor seating for 173 people for larger worship, weddings and memorials. The updated patio can also be a secluded, meditative space with labyrinth.

Starting in August view all redevelopment plan renderings in the church office and on the patio at weekend services.

**Securities:** Gifts of appreciated securities may offer significant tax benefits, reduce or eliminate capital gains. **Direct Payment From IRA:** Tax-free direct payment from an IRA. Please consult your IRA administrator and notify Bill Angus, redevelopment campaign Treasurer ([assttreasurer@stbartschurch.org](mailto:assttreasurer@stbartschurch.org)) to notify him how your donation from your IRA will be deposited in the church account.

**Matching Donations:** Some companies offer the benefit of matching charitable donations made by employees. Check with your Human Resources Department about this option for campaign donations.
